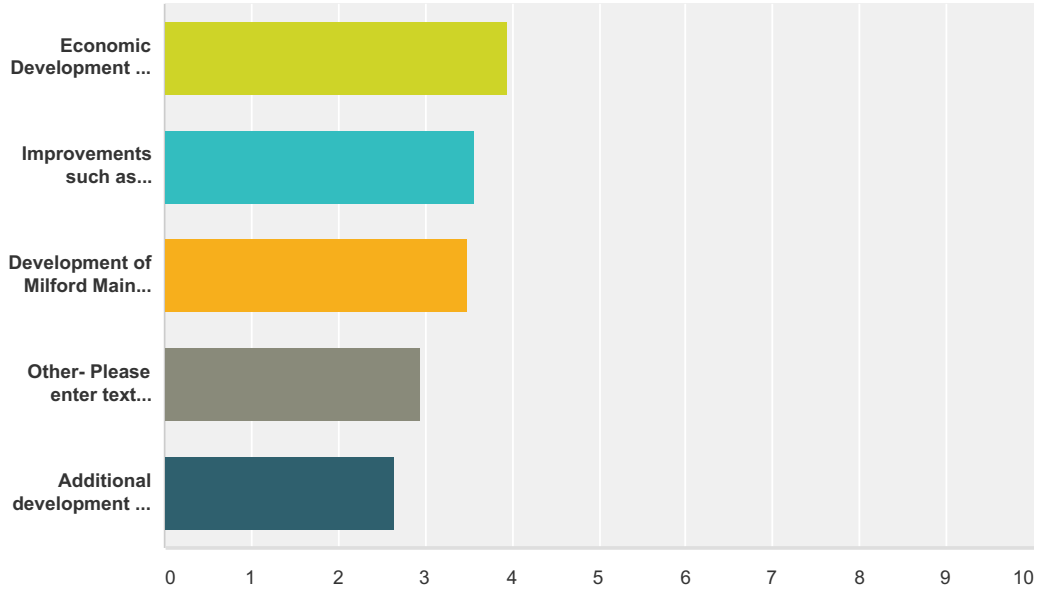


Q1 As the City makes budget decisions, what are the top priorities for the next five years? Please rank 1 through 4.

Q6 How often do you visit the public parks in the City of Milford?

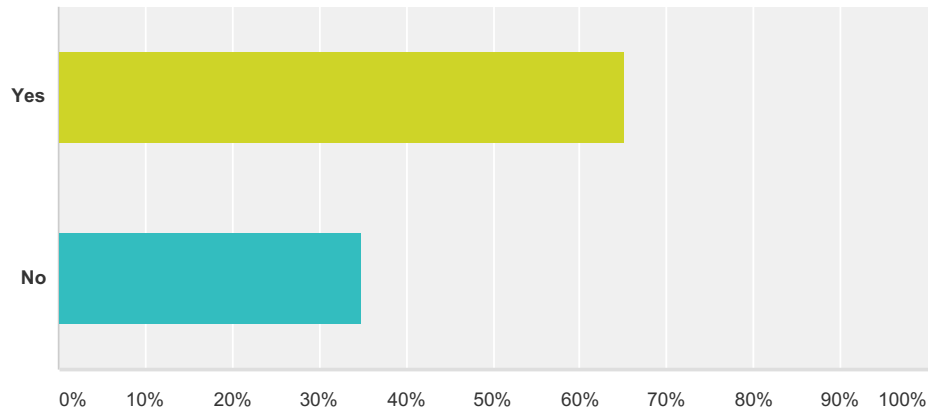

Q7 Would you support a park levy in order to fund capital improvements in the parks?

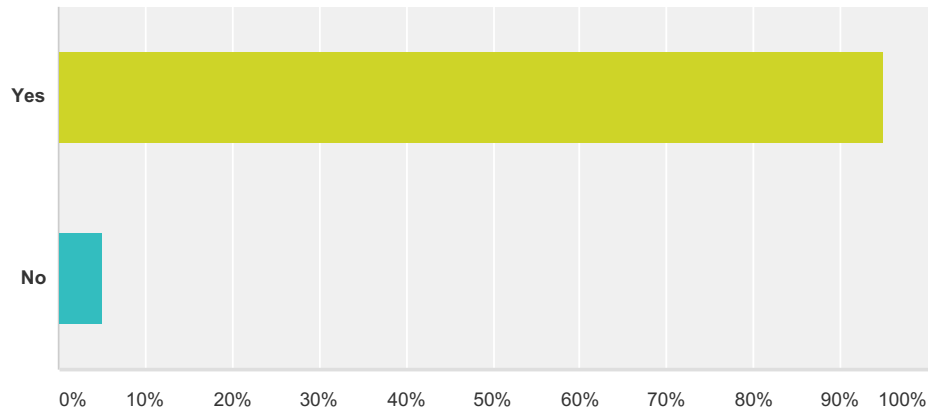

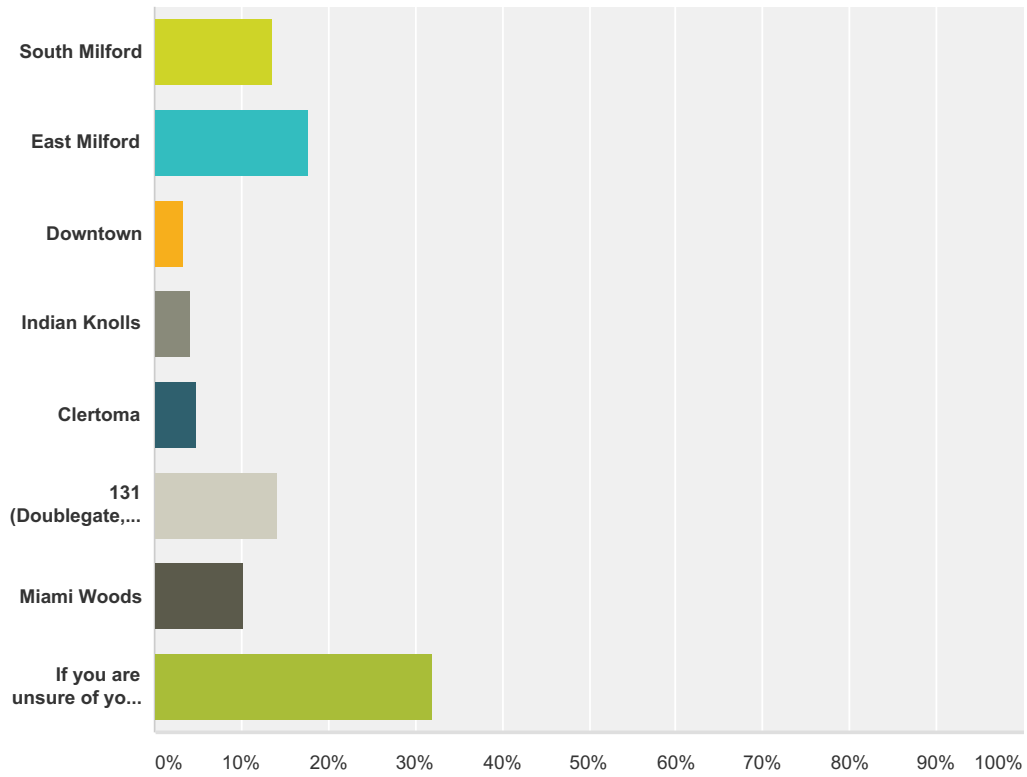
