



## **City of Milford, Ohio Waste Water Plant Operator**

The City of Milford, Ohio, is seeking applicants for the position of Waste Water Plant Operator, there are two positions available due to internal transfer and retirement.

Waste Water Plant Operator Responsibilities include maintaining test results and maintenance records in accordance with OEPA standards and City procedures, monitoring plant gauges and feeders, reading water meters, assisting in the repair of main breaks, as well as operation and repair of equipment as needed. These entry level positions are an excellent career opportunity for someone interested in ongoing training towards becoming a licensed Waste Water Treatment Plant Operator within two years, by passing the Ohio EPA Certification exam. The applicant must pass the City Waste Water Competitive Exam for an interview.

A Valid Ohio Driver's license is required and an Ohio Commercial Driver's License must be obtained within 6 months of date of hire. This safety sensitive position is subject to a background check and random drug and alcohol screening. Compensation for this position is a probationary rate of \$15.86 per hour with an excellent benefit package. Current Licensed Class I Operators will be compensated at a probationary rate of \$18.52.

The Waste Water competitive exam will be given on Saturday, August 11<sup>th</sup> at 10:00am, at the City of Milford Administrative Office, 745 Center Street, Milford, OH. The cost of each examination is \$10.00 (non-refundable) and must be paid by money order, cash or certified check at the time the application is submitted to the Administrative Office.

A separate Application must be submitted for each position if applying for more than one.
