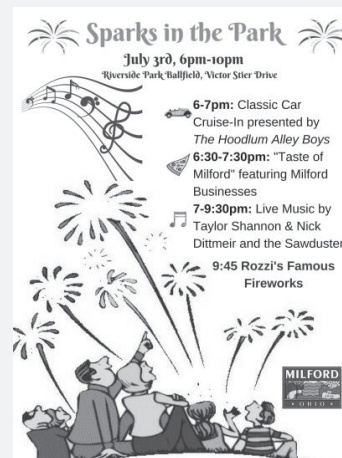

The Milford Community Fire Department thanks voters for their overwhelming support of the Fire/EMS tax levy renewal. This property tax is the primary means of support for the MCFD and it's renewal was important to maintaining fire and EMS protection at its current level.

In 2016 MCFD answered 1,650 EMS and 634 fire details, which is a 23% increase over the five years since 2012. The fire department strives to provide for a fast response to emergencies and have well-trained and equipped first responders, while keeping operating costs as low as possible. It also offers safety-related services to the community, like child safety seat installation, CPR and first aid training, gun trigger locks and other programs in an effort to be a better value for the tax payer's investment as well as promote a safer community, overall. 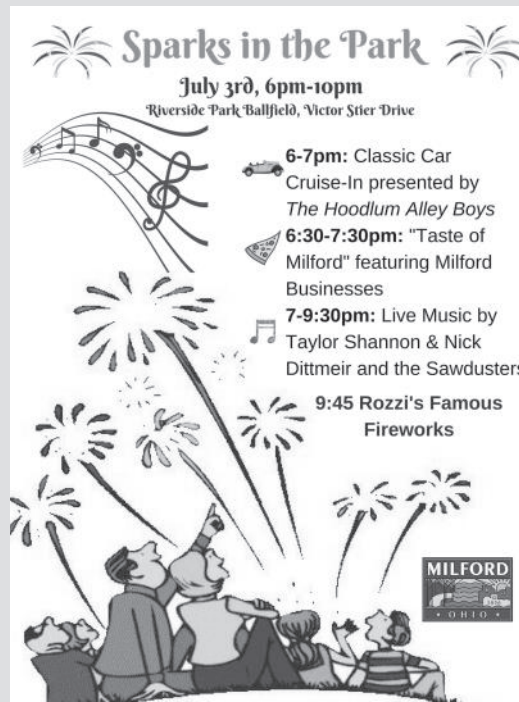

Downtown Milford Corridor Phase I Project

This summer we will begin work on the downtown Milford Corridor Project that will stretch from Castleberry Court to Five Points on Main Street/SR 28. The design calls for green space between the curb and sidewalks and the replacement of sidewalks, aprons and curbs. Other improvements include new crosswalks, removal of the turn lane past Valleyview to move the road away from the sidewalk, improved stormwater drainage and finally the repaving of the road from Five Points to Castlberry.
