

The Council of the City of Milford met in Special Session in Council Chambers at 745 Center Street at 7:00 p.m. on November 10, 2008.

Mayor Hunter called the meeting to order.

**Roll Call:** Present: Mayor Hunter, Vice-Mayor Hinnners, Ms. Brewer, Mr. Hawkins, and Mr. Vilardo, Jr. Mr. Vilardo, Jr. made a motion, seconded by Ms. Brewer to excuse Ms. McBeath and Mr. Pschesang. All voted yes.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the possible relocation and consolidation of overhead utilities on Main Street. Mayor Hunter introduced Duke Energy Representatives, Marvin Blade, Bill Hofstetter, Tom Birkenhaur and Kim Glenn.

Mr. Birkenhaur spoke to the residents and business owners outlining what Duke Energy would have to accomplish by moving the utility lines and the approximate costs. These costs would include the City's responsibility, and the responsibility of the residents and the business owners. Mr. Birkenhaur noted that there would be a lot of preliminary planning that would have to be done. Mr. Hofstetter also explained that this was an informational meeting so that the City, residents and business owners could understand what would take place if this was implemented.

Many questions were asked from those in attendance, including, Linda Yokel, Charles Evans, Charlene Hinnners, Mayor Hunter, Bryan Hawkins, Susanne Stagg, City Manager Rokey, John Cooper, Ralph Vilardo, Jr. and Art Price. Mr. Price stated that he was a long time business owner in downtown Milford. He said people should think about the next generation and that money invested will come back to you.

No decisions were made at this meeting, but more information would be available at future meetings. Mayor Hunter thanked the Duke Energy Representatives for attending the meeting.

**Adjourn:** There being no further business to come before the Special Meeting of Council Mr. Vilardo, Jr. made the motion to adjourn, seconded by Mayor Hunter. All voted yes. The meeting was adjourned at 7:50pm
