The City of Milford will soon begin construction projects on Water Street and Garfield Avenue. The projects involve the installation of a new water line, wastewater line and upgrades to the service garage lift station. Installation of the water line on Water Street should begin in 2-3 weeks, and the contractor will be working on a block by block basis while rerouting traffic around the block.

Construction work on Garfield Avenue will begin after Christmas. Garfield Avenue from Water Street to High Street will be closed completely. Garfield Avenue from High Street to Bay Road will be open for one lane of traffic. Flaggers will be present, but long delays are expected; drivers are encouraged to use alternate routes during the work on Garfield Avenue from High Street to Bay Road.

The project is expected to take approximately 8 months to complete. The objective is to install more reliable wastewater and water lines in the downtown area. Through the course of this project, Main Street will be open. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact City Hall at 831-4192.
