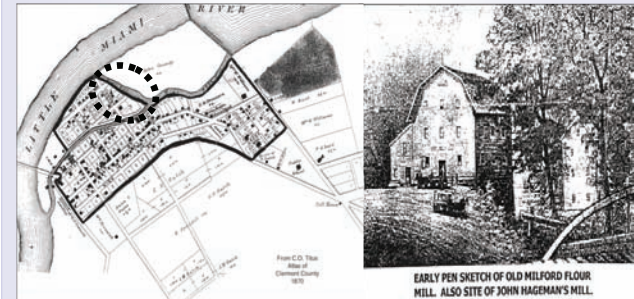

RIVERSIDE I & II PARKS MASTER PLAN



Milford is the unique junction of eight trails spanning over 22,000 miles. We have an opportunity to bring the traffic from the trails into the City with an inviting gateway, Riverside I and II Parks.

History: Mill Race



Milford was a mill town (i.e. flour, saw, and oil). The dashed circle above shows where a mill race once flowed and created the channel still visible at Riverside II Park today.

Civic Events: Frontier Days



Milford has become a host of annual events which tap the surroundings, anchored in the core downtown: Memorial Day Parade; Frontier Days; Junction Trail Festival; Buskerfest; Hometown Holidays; and various outdoor exhibits. The Master Plan would allow a variety of events to occur from concerts to programmed events.

Memorial: Honoring Veterans



Milford continues to honor veterans past and present. The Master Plan would include moving the memorial closer to the American Legion along with one or more flags and commemorative elements to create a place of honor.
