

The Council of the City of Milford met in Special Session in Council Chambers at 745 Center Street at 7:00 p.m. on March 23, 2010. Mayor Brewer called the meeting to order.

Roll Call: Mayor Brewer, Vice-Mayor Vilardo, Jr., Mr. Rohrig, Ms. Hinnners, Mr. Hawkins, Ms. Walter and Mr. Pittman.

The purpose of this special meeting was to finalize the 2010 Milford City Budget for adoption. City Manager Rokey stated that by amending the allocations to the General Fund at 92.4%, allocating 5.5% to the Capital fund and allocating 2.1% to the Parks & Recreation fund a balanced budget could be achieved.

Council discussed and agreed with the allocations. Mr. Pittman made the motion, seconded by Mr. Rohrig to draft an Ordinance to make Appropriations for the current expenses and other expenditures of the City of Milford during the Fiscal Year ending December 31, 2010. All voted yes.

Mr. Pittman made the motion to adopt the Ordinance, seconded by Mr. Vilardo, Jr. All voted yes.

Mr. Vilardo, Jr. made a motion, seconded by Ms. Walter to draft an Ordinance to Amend the Income Tax Collection Codified Ordinance 181.21 to read pursuant to this chapter, 92.4% funds collected be allocated to the General Fund, 5.5% shall be allocated to the Capital Improvements Fund and 2.1% shall be allocated to the Parks % Recreation Fund. All voted yes.

Mr. Pittman made a motion at 7:10 p.m. to adjourn to Executive Session pursuant to Section 3.05 (1) of the Milford City Charter to consider the dismissal of a city employee, seconded by Ms. Hinnners. All voted yes. Council will return to the Special Council meeting at the conclusion of the Executive Session.

Council returned to the Special Session of Council at 7:30 p.m. with a motion from Mr. Hawkins, seconded by Ms. Walter. All voted yes.

Mr. Pittman made the motion to immediately dismiss Tim Petic, Financial Director, seconded by Ms. Walter. Voting Yes: Ms. Brewer, Ms. Hinnners, Mr. Vilardo, Jr., Ms. Walter, and Mr. Pittman. Voting No: Mr. Rohrig and Mr. Hawkins.

With no other business to come before the Special meeting of Council it was adjourned at 7:35 p.m. with a motion from Mr. Vilardo, Jr., seconded by Mr. Hawkins. All voted yes.
