

The Council of the City of Milford met in a Special Session in Council Chambers at 745 Center Street at 6:00 p.m. October 26, 2010. Mayor Vilardo, Jr. called the meeting to order.

Roll Call: Present: Mayor Vilardo, Jr., Vice Mayor Pittman, Mr. Rohrig, Ms. Hinners, Ms. Brewer, Ms. Walter, and Mr. Lykins.

Purpose of the Meeting: To discuss and consider Chief Cooper's proposals for on-street parking and items discussed at the Safety Services meeting.

Mayor Vilardo asked Mr. Pittman to give an overview concerning the on-street parking, elimination of parking spaces in downtown Milford and on other streets in the City. Chief Cooper was asked if he had any further comment. He stated nothing further than what he had in his report to Safety Services.

Mayor Vilardo opened the agenda for public comments. Many residents spoke about their concerns about parking on Mound St., access to emergency vehicles from alleys, one side or two side parking on Mound St., elimination of parking spaces downtown Milford or leaving them as is. Sgt. Burroughs distributed copies of the traffic analysis in South Milford to the Council members. Discussion continued with residents and Council members on these matters.

Mayor Vilardo made a motion to modify the current Ordinance. Discussion was held concerning parking spaces and stop sign and fire hydrant parking. Mr. Pittman motioned that the City Manager talk to the Law Director concerning language for an Ordinance amendment or change concerning ODOT rules and the State Code. Both Mayor Vilardo and Mr. Pittman withdrew their motions and agreed to meet with Mr. Minniear and discuss a proposed ordinance of a modified ordinance if one was needed. This issue will be brought up during the October 3rd Council Meeting.

There were no further comments to come before Council.

Adjourn: Ms. Hinners made the motion to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Pittman. The meeting was adjourned at 6:45 p.m. with all voting yes.
